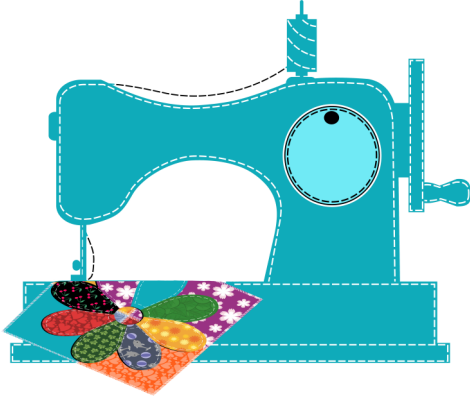

2018 Quilt College - Class Descriptions:

- A. Beyond the Stars** Common Bias Quilting Bayfield, WI
Explore an easy, accurate method for producing perfect stars, beautiful pine forests, and flocks of flying geese moving in perfect formation. Using joined bias strips, elongated triangles and squares to take the frustration out of those pesky triangles.
- B. "Panel-Palooza"** Antoinette's Quilt Shop, LLC Plover, WI
Panels are irresistible! We buy them because they are cute or pretty or unique. But, when we get home, what do we do with them? Join Nora for an inspiring creative session on just that topic! All class supplies provided. If you have a specific panel you want ideas on, bring it along.
- C. Have your Cake and Make It Too!** Village Creek Lodi, WI
We will explore just what you get out of a package of 10" squares and the pros and cons to using them. Trunk show and short demos on how fast and easy these quilts are to make. You will be amazed.
- D. Fabric Cards** Creative Hideaway Dorchester, WI
Make cards with fabric by using your scraps or make a card to match your quilt you give as a gift. These are fun and inexpensive cards to make.
- E. Color Theory** The Quilting Workshop Wausau, WI
Do you always seem to love everyone else's quilts but are never quite as happy with your color choices? Do you like to buy kits because you are uncertain about your ability to choose colors? If so, here is a class for you! Learn basic color theory and how to use it in quilts as well as how to find inspiration for your next quilt in unexpected places. Many examples will be shown to make you more comfortable with the process.
- F. Not all Bindings are Square** Pie Safe Quilts Weston, WI
Learn what binding size to cut, cutting on straight of grain or bias binding, how to attach binding to rectangular and non-rectangular quilts, how to join the binding together and the difference of machine vs. hand sewing binding.
- G. Rulers for Machine Quilting** Sew Smart Sewing Wausau, WI
Learn how to use rulers for machine quilting. Learn the pros and cons, the basics and try before you buy. Machines will be set up for you to try the rulers.
- H. Flower Pockets** RagSpun Studio LLC Brandon, WI
Learn how to make adorably unique Flower Pockets. Using several different fabrics (scraps especially!!!), you will learn the technique to put these together in no time. Adding Flowers to your wall is so pretty next to any picture!!! These make great gift items also...
- I. W.O.W. – World of Wool** The Woolgathering, LLC Merrill, WI
Learn tips and techniques for working with wool appliqué. We will discuss the various notions available to be used in wool work, how and why we use them to make it easy and be successful. There will be lots of samples from the basics and beyond. I hope you will join me.
- J. Scan and Cut Machine** Ana's Sewing Center Wausau, WI
See the Scan and Cut machine in action, Ana will demonstrate the machine showing how to cut accurate shapes and block pieces.
- K. Quilts for Scrap Lovers** Bungalow Quilting and Yarn Ripon, WI
Learn how to group colors from your scrap stash into meaningful combinations. Also learn how to use scraps that may be too odd or ugly and to use them in combinations to make them relevant. Learn how to bring together scraps from all different genres of fabric for use in any one quilt. Be amazed at how a bunch of scraps that seem like they would never work together would actually work!
- L. Jelly Roll Rug or Placemat** Fabric Patch Ironwood, MI
Learn how to turn a Jelly Roll or any 2.5 inch strip into a rug or placemat. There are easy tips and tricks that will make these so easy.
- M. Fabulous Fractures** Sew Pieceful Tomahawk, WI
Learn a fun and innovative way to use fabric. This is done by cutting four identical layers of fabric with the same repeat and sewing them back together to create a pixelated effect. This is perfect to use on a variety of bold florals and small panels.
- N. Sashiko** Sew Creative, Rhinelander, WI
Learn this hand stitch art that has many designs and is very beautiful. Learn about the designs, different threads, needles and patterns.
