

PTQ Starred, 9-1/2"

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All seams 1/4".

This block focuses on making;

1. Flying geese units using the (4)-at a time method



2. Half square triangles using the (8) at a time method



Materials

Item	Quantity	Size, Fabric Description
A	4	2" x 3-1/2", Background
B	1	3-1/2" Square, Background
C	8	2" squares, Patterned
4 at a time Flying Geese Trim to 2" x 3-1/2"		
D	4	2-5/8" Sq, Background
E	1	4-1/2" Sq, Patterned
8 at a time HST's (Half Square Triangles) Trim to 2"		
F	1	5-1/2", Background
G	1	5-1/2", Patterned

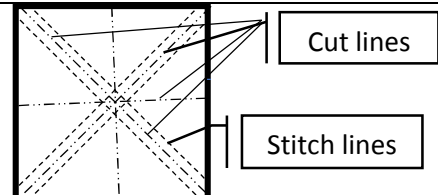
Instructions

4 at a time Flying Geese Trim to 2" x 3-1/2"

On (4)-"D" - 2-5/8" draw a line from one corner to the opposite corner on the wrong side of fabric. Place a "D" on opposite corners of "E". Stitch 1/4" from the drawn line across both pieces of "D". Cut in (2)-pieces on the drawn line. Press seams toward "D". On each of the triangles formed place (1)-"D" sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. You will now have (4)-flying geese. Press seam toward the "D". Trim to 2" x 3-1/2" with the apex of the triangle from "E" at 1/4" from the trimmed edge.

(8)-at a time HST's Trim to 2"

On (1)-"F" - 5-1/2" background on the wrong side of fabric, draw a line from one corner to the opposite corner forming a diagonal drawn cross. Place a "F" directly on top of G. Stitch 1/4" from the drawn lines across on "F". Cut in (2)-pieces on the drawn line. above. Press seams to the darker fabric. Trim to 2" square.



Sew (2)-HST's to (2)-"C"'s as shown. Make (4)-units.



Sew (1) Flying Goose to each of (4)-"A"'s to make (4)-Geese units. Press toward "A".

Sew orientated as shown in illustration above. Press seams open. Trim to 9-1/2" square.
