

	<p>PTQ Rows of Geese, 9-1/2" Contact Cathy Teske Home (715) 675-6848 All seams 1/4". Use a short stitch length of 1.5 to 1.8 mm.</p> <p>This block focuses on making Flying geese units using the paper piecing method.</p> <p>True confessions I press after adding the "A/B" pieces and again after the "A" pieces are added....many would not find that to their liking...you do you.</p>
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Materials

Item	Quantity	Size, Fabric Description	
A	18	3"-3-1/4" square, Background, cut each square on the diagonal once	<i>Size of square depends on how much excess fabric you wish to trim off. Using the larger size requires less precise placement.</i>
B	3	3"-3-1/4" Square, Patterned, cut each square on the diagonal once	
C	6	3"-3-1/4"" squares, patterned, cut each square on the diagonal once	
D	3-strips	Flying geese paper	

Instructions

Strips of paper pieced Flying Geese to make 2" x 3-1/2" flying geese strips

Make (3) rows of (6)-flying geese each using the paper pattern provided.

- (1)-strip with "B" as the center of the strip and "A" at the outside of the strip.
- (2)-strips with "C" as the center of the strip and "A" at the outside of the strip.

The papers "D" are numbered in the sequence that fabric should be added on the **backside** of the papers stitching on the seam lines on the front of the papers.

Fold papers on the seam lines prior to adding the fabrics **OR** as you are trimming fabric to 1/4" from the seam line.

Sequence of placement is noted on the strips. Start each strip with either a "B" or a "C" piece in position 1 right side up. It may help to glue/pin/baste this first piece in place. Next an "A" piece on first on one side, finger press then the other side, right side to "A/B" piece. Trim excess of "A", "B" & "C" to 1/4" from the seam line after each piece is added to the strip.

Trim each strip to 3-1/2" wide x 9-1/2" lg on the solid lines on the outside of the strip.

Sew (3)-strips of Flying geese together orientated as shown on the dashed lines, matching points along the length of the strips as in illustration at the top of the page.

Remove paper. Press seams open.

Trim to 9-1/2" square.
