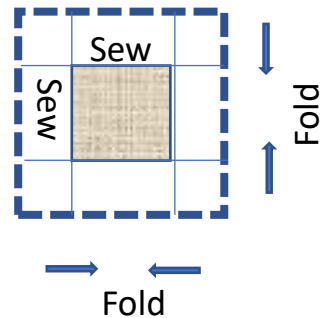


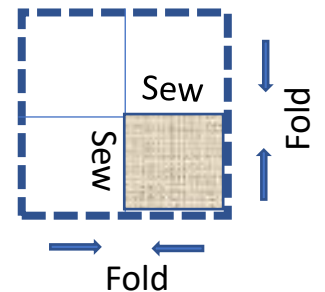
# Fold and Sew Demo

- Blocks can be made with;
  - Cake Layers (Background)
  - Charm Squares (Accent)
  - Jelly Rolls (Sashing)

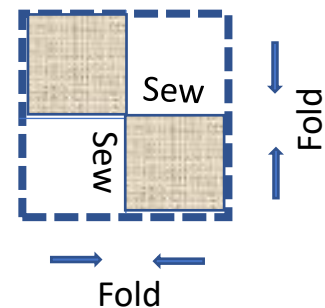
- Square in a Square (centered)
  - Fold (left/right) sides to meet in the center
  - Sew/Press
  - Fold sides (up/down) to meet in the center
  - Sew/Press



- Corner Blocks (window pane look)
  - Fold in half (to the left or right)
  - Sew/Press
  - Fold in half (to the top or bottom)
  - Sew/Press

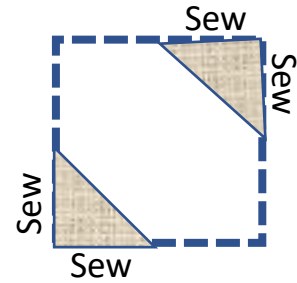


- Opposite Corners (four square look)
  - Fold in half (to the left or right)
  - Sew/Press
  - Fold in half (to the top or bottom)
  - Sew/Press



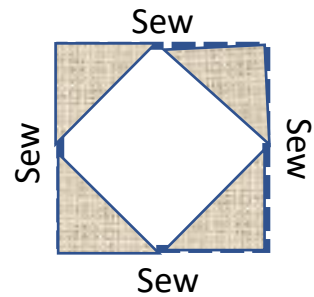
## • Corner Triangles

- Take two Charm Squares and fold/press in half
- Sew along the outside edges
- This will leave the inside open which can be used for pockets on a child's quilt)
- If you don't want to leave it open you can sew the inside flap down as well



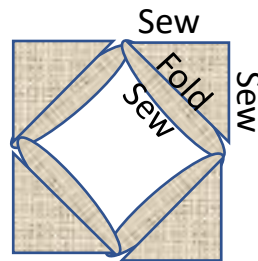
## • Triangle in every corner

- Take four Charm Squares and fold/press in half
- Sew along the outside edges
- You can leave the inside edge open or sew down



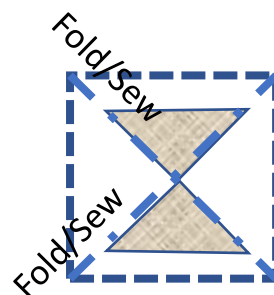
## • Curved Edged Triangles

- Use the pattern for a triangle in every corner above
- Fold back and sew the bias edge for a curved edge look



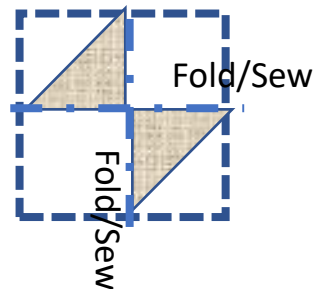
## • Hour Glass Triangles

- Take two Charm Squares and fold/press in half
- Fold your 10" square in half, finger press so you see where to place your triangle
- Place your CS triangles
- Fold your 10' square into a triangle (L bottom corner to R top corner) and sew
- Then fold your 10' square into a triangle (R bottom corner to L top corner) and sew



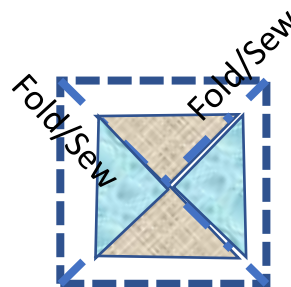
## • Hour Glass at an Angle

- Take two Charm Squares and fold/press in half
- Fold your 10" square in half, finger press so you see where to place your triangle
- Place your CS triangles
- Fold your 10' square in half (bottom to top) and sew
- Then fold your 10' square in half (side to side) and sew



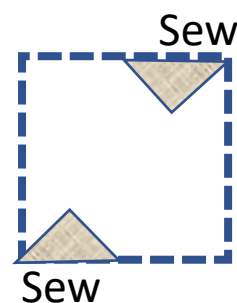
## • Double Hour Glass

- Take 4 Charm Squares and fold/press in half
- Fold your 10" square in half, finger press so you see where to place your triangle
- Place your CS triangles
- Fold your 10' square into a triangle (L bottom corner to R top corner) and sew
- Then fold your 10' square into a triangle (R bottom corner to L top corner) and sew



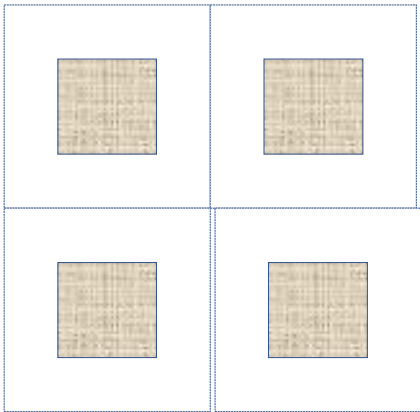
## • Triangle Tips

- Fold Charm Squares twice then fold/press
- Sew to edges at random (2, 3 or 4)
- This will leave no raw edges on the inside
- Leave triangle loose or sew them down
- Great idea for a baby quilt as babies like tactile quilts.

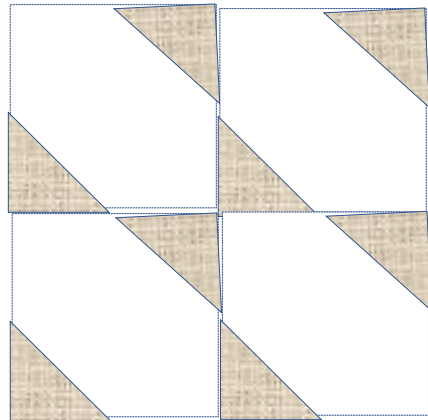

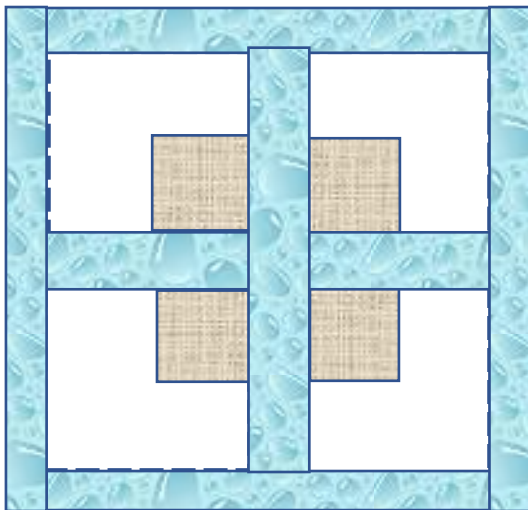
## Square in a Square (Centered)



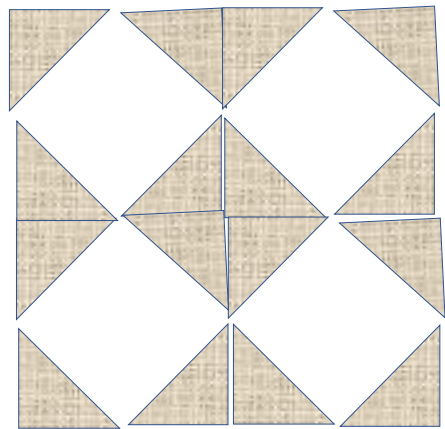
## Corner Triangles



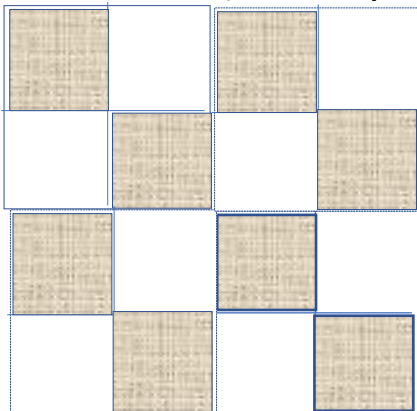
## Corner Blocks (Window Pane Look)



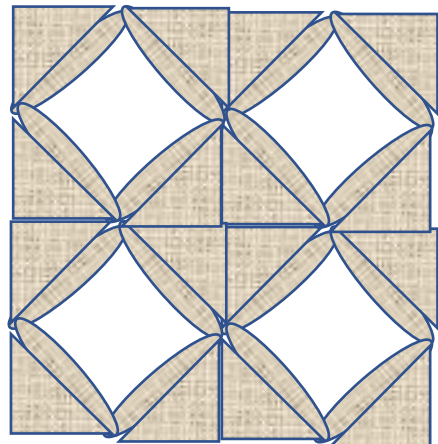
## Triangle in Every Corner



## Opposite Corners (Four Square Look)

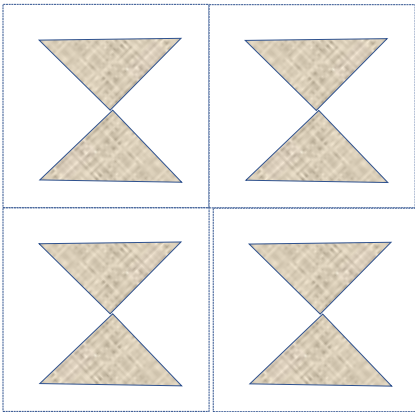


## Curved Edge Triangle

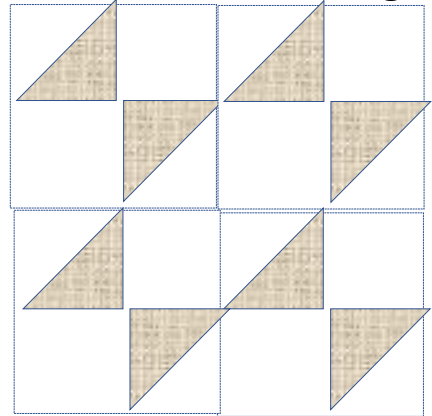

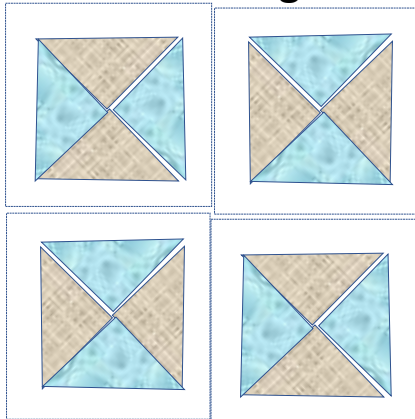
## Hour Glass Triangles



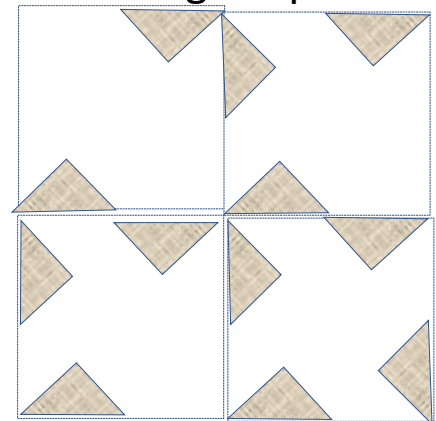
## Hour Glass at an Angle
