## **Guidelines for block exchange**

Block is to be 6-1/2" unfinished

Use Christmas colors of green, reds, creams, whites or blues. No novelty fabrics. Fabrics may be solid or print using quilt shop fabric please

Design is your choice and you need to make 6 blocks

Label your blocks within the seam allowance or by using a mailing label or a tag pinned to each block

Put all your blocks (6) in a paper bag with your name printed on the bag

All blocks must be turned in to Joan Dombrowski by the November 22nd meeting

At the holiday party, you will receive one of your blocks along with 5 other blocks from fellow quilters

If you don't attend the party, the blocks will be given to you at the January meeting

## **Guidelines for potholder exchange**

1-please make potholders around 8 inches

2-use Christmas colors but no novelty prints please

3-bring potholders to a guild meeting by November 22nd and turn in to Linda Maly

4-sign in notebook, your name and how many potholders you made so we can have you pick the appropriate number at the holiday party

5-place name somewhere on the potholders along with the year

At the holiday party, the potholders will be exchanged among the participants
