

Crazy Quilt Block

Cut out a five sided center block with sides that are different angles and lengths. See the sample below.

Right sides together sew a strip to one side of the center block. You can start on any side. Press the Seam to the piece that you just added.

Trim the added strip to extend the angle of the original block on both ends of the added strip.

Working around the block clockwise, continue adding strips to the block pressing and trimming both ends of each new strip after it is added.

After you have added a strip to each of the five sides of the original block you will have completed the first round. You will need to continue to add rounds until your piece is large enough to cut out the desired size square.

As you continue to add rounds try to keep the center (original 5 sided block) in or near as possible of the center of block that you are building.

.Square your block to $9\frac{1}{2}$
